ENROLMENT APPLICATION FEE

Required with Enrolment Application (inc GST, Non-refundable): \$275

CONFIRMATION FEE

Required to confirm a place when offered by the School (Non-refundable)

Pre-School and Kindergarten: \$1,000 Primary School (Year 1 – 6): \$1,750 Secondary School (Year 7 – 12): \$2,500

CLERGY DISCOUNTS

Special provision may be made for the children of full time, ordained Ministers in certain circumstances. Fees are available on application. Application for a Clergy Discount should be directed to the Principal.

Where more than one discount applies, only the greater discount is applicable.

SUNDRY CHARGES

Sundry charges will appear on Fee Statements when optional activities such as Instrument Hire, Theatresports, The Duke of Edinburgh Awards, Overseas Tours, TVet courses etc are participated in or there is a charge imposed for lost or damaged school items. Additionally, charges apply per student for access to the School Bus on the morning and afternoon run – \$5 per trip and \$10 per day, capped at \$40 per week.

FINANCIAL HARDSHIP

Fee relief may be offered on the basis of demonstrated financial merit and/or need. If genuine financial difficulties are experienced by a family at the School, please immediately direct a letter applying for 'Fee Relief' to the Business Manager.

GST

Under current law, GST is not payable on fees relating to tuition. If applicable, the School reserves the right to apply GST in accordance with legislation current at the time.

FEES IN ADVANCE

The School offers options for the payment of more than one year's fees in advance. Details are available from the Business Manager, noting the close date for this option is end of Term 2, 2017.

BUILDING AND LIBRARY FUNDS

Future development of the School relies to a considerable extent on money raised through voluntary contributions to the Building and Library Funds. Building alterations, minor building projects, major renovations and new buildings are made possible by Building Fund donations, as Tuition Fees are not set to cover this work.

Parents and Guardians are expected to contribute \$300 per term per family to the Building Fund. Families are encouraged to contribute more than the suggested amounts to the Building Fund, and separately to the Library Fund, when their circumstances allow them to do so.

Contributions to the Building and Library Funds are fully tax deductible. Receipts are issued at the end of each financial year.

FEE PAYMENT

Fees can be paid online at www.arden.nsw.edu.au, click on Quick Links and select Online Payments. Please provide the Account Number shown on the top right hand side of the Fee Statement and the family surname when making payments.

When paying an Enrolment Application Fee or Confirmation Fee, please use the student name as the reference.

CHARGES & PENALTIES

Payment of Fees by credit card attracts a surcharge. Applicable bank fees will be charged to Fee Statements for dishonoured cheques.

If fees are not paid on time, nor an agreed payment plan in place, an Administration Fee of \$75 will be applied to the Fee Statement. Should there be continued failure to clear the balance outstanding, the School is entitled to charge a fee equal to 1% per month or part thereof, to the balance of the account outstanding from the due date for payment of fees.

Consideration for inclusion and/or participation in overseas tours is conditional upon the Account being up to date.

WITHDRAWAL

It is a Condition of Enrolment that one full term's notice of withdrawal of a student be given in writing to the Principal. A full term's fees will be charged in lieu of this notice, in addition to all other fees payable.
