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## ARDEN UNIFORM

Arden students are expected to wear their School Uniform with pride. Students represent the School every day whether on public transport, during an excursion or as members of our local communities. We remain vigilant with uniform standards and ask that parents support our efforts to ensure that the compulsory Arden uniform is always well presented, clean and in good order.

All uniform items for students from Pre-school to Year 12 (except shoes) are available from the Arden Uniform Shop, which is located at Suite 2, 44-46 Oxford Street, Epping.

There is ample parking on Oxford Street and there is no need to enter school grounds to access the shop.

Regular opening hours during School terms are published on the School's portal, *Schoolbox*. Special opening hours during School Holidays will be communicated to parents from time-to-time.

## GENERAL GUIDELINES

Please note the following general guidelines:

- Girls are required to wear their dress or skirt at knee length
- Boys are expected to have their shirt tucked in and the top button done up on their shirt.
- The boys tie is compulsory and must be worn correctly.
- Hair is always to be neat and tidy.
- Girls hair that is longer than shoulder length must be tied back with a green and/or white hair accessories.
- Boys hair should be cut short. Tapered, fade, undercut or buzz cuts are not permitted.
- Makeup and nail polish are not to be worn at school
- Jewellery, including necklaces and chains, is not permitted (medical tags excluded). Girls with pierced ears may only wear one pair of plain studs (no sleepers) in their ear lobes. Boys are not to wear jewellery of any kind, excluding a watch.
- Senior boys are to be clean shaven.
- Black school shoes (no Velcro) are required for the formal uniform.
- Runners are required for the sports uniform.

### SUMMER

Worn in Terms 1 and 4.

Summer dress with green socks and black leather Velcro straps shoes.

Anklet socks that do not show above the shoe are not permitted. The socks must fold over and sit above the shoe.

### WINTER

Worn in Terms 2 and 3.

Track suit with either short or long-sleeved crested polo.

Arden sports socks and generic runners.

*There is no Physical Education (PE) Uniform for Pre-School students.*

## PRE-SCHOOL

### SUMMER

Worn in Terms 1 and 4.

Crested short-sleeved polo with Arden sports socks and runners.

### WINTER

Worn in Terms 2 and 3.

Track suit with either short or long-sleeved crested polo.

Arden sports socks with generic runners.

## GIRLS

## KINDERGARTEN-YEAR 6



### SUMMER

Worn in Terms 1 and 4.

Summer dress with green socks and black lace-up leather shoes.

Panama Hat is worn to and from School every day.

Blazer is optional but can be worn on cooler days or to and from School.

Jumper or vest is optional but can be worn at School, or under the blazer to and from School. The jumper must not be worn on its own to and from School.

Anklet socks that do not show above the shoe are not permitted. The socks must fold over and sit above the shoe.

### WINTER

Worn in Terms 2 and 3.

Tunic with long sleeved white shirt and tie.

Green knee-high socks or green tights (note: for School photos or excursions, the green knee-high socks must be worn).

Blazer must be worn to and from School.

Jumper or vest is worn at School or under blazer to and from School. The jumper must not be worn on its own to and from School.

## BOYS

## KINDERGARTEN-YEAR 6



### SUMMER

Worn in Terms 1 and 4.

Grey shorts with short sleeved white shirt with School tie, green knee-high socks and black leather lace-up shoes (note: the tie shown above is specific to K - Year 6).

The baggy green cap is worn to and from School.

Blazer is optional but can be worn to and from School.

Jumper is optional but can be worn at School, or under the blazer to and from School. The jumper must not be worn on its own to and from School.

### WINTER

Worn in Terms 2 and 3.

Grey shorts with long sleeved white shirt. School tie, green knee-high socks and black leather lace-up shoes.

Grey trousers are optional (note: for School photos or excursion, the grey shorts must be worn). If trousers are selected, short grey socks must be worn.

Blazer must be worn to and from School.

Jumper is optional but can be worn at School or under blazer to and from School. The jumper must not be worn on its own to and from School.

Shorts and trousers must not be substituted for other styles/brands.





### SUMMER

Worn in Terms 1 and 4.

Summer dress with white socks and black lace-up leather shoes.

Blazer is optional in Terms 1 & 4 but can be worn on cooler days or to and from School.

Jumper is optional but can be worn at School, or under the blazer to and from School. The jumper must not be worn on its own to and from School.

Anklet socks that do not show above the shoe are not permitted. The socks must fold over and sit above the shoe.

### WINTER

Worn in Terms 2 and 3.

Light grey plaid skirt and crested white blouse including the tie tab, with either green knee-high socks or green tights (note: for School photos or excursions, the green knee-high socks must be worn).

Blazer is compulsory in Terms 2 & 3 when travelling to and from School.

Jumper is optional but can be worn at School, or under the blazer to and from School. The jumper must not be worn on its own to and from School.



## BOYS

## YEARS 7-10



### SUMMER/WINTER

Worn all year

Grey trousers with short sleeved white crested shirt, grey socks, tie and black belt (note: the tie shown above is specific to Years 7-10).

Blazer is optional in Terms 1 & 4 but can be worn on cooler days or to and from School. Blazer is compulsory in Terms 2 & 3 when travelling to and from School.

Jumper is optional but can be worn at School, or under the blazer to and from School. The jumper must not be worn on its own to and from School.

Trousers must not be substituted for other styles/brands.



### SUMMER

Dark grey plaid skirt with crested white blouse including the tie tab, white socks and black lace-up shoes.

Blazer is optional in Terms 1 & 4 but can be worn on cooler days or to and from School.

Jumper is optional but can be worn at School, or under the blazer to and from School. The jumper must not be worn on its own to and from School.

Anklet socks that do not show above the shoe are not permitted. The socks must fold over and sit above the shoe.

### WINTER

Dark grey plaid skirt with crested white blouse, either green knee-high socks or green tights and black lace-up leather shoes (note: for School photos or excursions, the green knee-high socks must be worn).

Blazer is compulsory in Terms 2 & 3 when travelling to and from School.

Jumper is optional but can be worn at School, or under the blazer to and from School. The jumper must not be worn on its own to and from School.



### SUMMER/WINTER

Worn all year (from Term 4 in Year 10).

Grey trousers with short sleeved white crested shirt, grey socks, tie and black belt (note: the tie shown above is specific to Years 11-12).

Blazer is optional in Terms 1 & 4 but can be worn on cooler days or to and from School. Blazer is compulsory in Terms 2 & 3 when travelling to and from School.

Jumper is optional but can be worn at School, or under the blazer to and from School. The jumper must not be worn on its own to and from School.

Trousers must not be substituted for other styles/brands.

## PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE) UNIFORM GIRLS & BOYS

## KINDERGARTEN – YEAR 6



### SUMMER

Worn two days per week in Terms 1 and 4.

Crested polo based on student House with sports shorts, Arden sports socks and runners (no skate shoes are permitted).

The track jacket is optional. Track pants are not worn during Terms 1 and 4.

### WINTER

Worn two days per week in Terms 2 and 3.

Tracksuit with crested polo based on student House, Arden sports socks and generic runners (no skate shoes are permitted).



## PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE) UNIFORM

### GIRLS & BOYS

YEARS 7-12



### SUMMER/WINTER

Worn for Physical Education lessons.

Crested polo based on student House with sports shorts, Arden sports socks and runners (no skate shoes are permitted).

The track jacket is compulsory and cannot be substituted for the School jumper.

The track pants are optional.

The sports bag is required to bring PE uniform to School on the appropriate days.

## GIRLS SWIMWEAR

YEARS 2-12



Arden swimwear must be worn at all School swimming events and carnivals. Options include:

Full piece swimmers.

Rashie Wet Shirts.

Swim caps (latex or silicon) in relevant House colour.

Board shorts (For Years 5-12 only).

## BOYS SWIMWEAR

YEARS 2-12



Arden swimwear must be worn at all School swimming events and carnivals. Options include:

Speedo style swimmers.

Long Leg Jammers.

Rashie Wet Shirts.

Swim caps (latex or silicon) in relevant House colour.

Board shorts (For Years 5-12 only).
